# School Tuition Fees 2010-2011 Academic Year

### DAY FEES

Grade	Full Year Tuition Fees
Frog Hollow Nursery (half day)	£5,750
Pre-K	£8,950

Frog Hollow Nursery and Pre-K fees are inclusive of tuition, classroom materials, most activities, and a morning snack.

Grade	Full Year Tuition Fees
K-3	£15,250
4-8	£17,100
9-13	£18,650

Fees include lunches, loan of textbooks, IT and laboratory fees, some classroom materials, and the cost of most curriculum-related activities and field trips.

### BOARDING FEES

Boarding Program	Fees
Full Year*	£30,600

\* The Full Year's Fee is discounted by 3% if the payment of £29,682 is received by June 1<sup>st</sup> 2010. Please note new students will also need to forward the Development Fund fee (£750) with this amount. Any discounted fees are not refundable under any circumstances.

Fees include tuition, room and board, loan of textbooks, most IT and laboratory fees, annual laptop maintenance, some classroom materials, most curriculum-related activities and field trips, weekly linen service for bed linen and towels, travel insurance for school-sponsored trips, and the Fall Travel Week.

#### Fees for students joining TASIS for the 1st or 2nd semester only:

1st Semester Only	£17,500
2nd Semester Only	£15,500

#### OTHER REQUIRED FEES

Medical Insurance is required and is the responsibility of the parents.

### PAYMENT SCHEDULE

#### APPLICATION FEE

An application fee of £125 must accompany each application form. We are unable to issue an invoice for the application fee, but a receipt can be forwarded upon request.

#### ENROLLMENT DEPOSIT

Following a student's acceptance, an enrollment form and a deposit of £1,000 for day students and £2,000 for boarding students will be required to hold the place. The deposit must

be paid by the date specified in the acceptance letter or the place will be forfeited. If the deposit is not received by this date, priority will be given to other applicants. For day students, this deposit will be applied toward the second semester tuition. If the student fails to enter or withdraws from school, the deposit will be retained by the School.

Acceptance and enrollment constitute a contract to pay the entire year's fees, and there is no reduction or refund for absence, withdrawal, or dismissal.

#### DAY STUDENT TUITION FEES

For day students, the first tuition fee installment (60% of the full year fee) plus the one-time-only Development Fund fee for new students (£750) are due on 1<sup>st</sup> June, or 14 days from date of invoice if issued after 1<sup>st</sup> June. The remaining fees, less the enrollment deposit, are payable on 15<sup>th</sup> November. Accounts must be settled in full on or before the 1<sup>st</sup> day of each semester. Fee payments not received by the due date will be subject to late payment fees. Students will not be allowed to start school until fees have been paid. No records, diplomas, recommendations, or grade reports will be released until all financial obligations have been met.

#### BOARDING STUDENT TUITION FEES

Payment by semester requires receipt of 70% of the fees (£21,420), for new students (£22,170) which includes the one-time-only Development Fund fee (£750). This must be received by 1<sup>st</sup> June, or 14 days from date of invoice if issued after 1<sup>st</sup> June. The remaining payment of 30% of the fees (£9,180) is to be received by 15<sup>th</sup> November. Accounts must be settled in full on or before the 1<sup>st</sup> day of each semester. Fee payments not received by the due date will be subject to late payment fees. Students will not be allowed to start school until fees have been paid. No records, diplomas, recommendations, or grade reports will be released until all financial obligations have been met.

### DEVELOPMENT FUND

All new students pay a one-time-only Development Fund fee of £750 towards the School's ongoing building and maintenance program.

### FINANCIAL AID

TASIS encourages students who are unable to meet the full costs of the School to apply for financial aid. Grants are awarded on an individual basis according to need and an applicant's potential to contribute to, and benefit from, the School's program. Students who have been awarded financial aid need to re-apply for continued assistance each academic year.
